Support projects that make communities less susceptible to disasters through investment in community resilience and disaster mitigation projects.

Funding projects that establish or expand parks, outdoor recreation areas, and outdoor recreation programs.

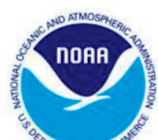
